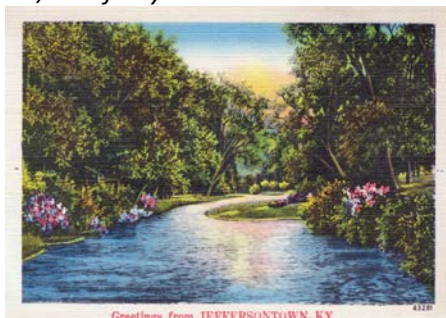
Images of Paul Ratterman's Beatles Memorabilia exhibit, currently on display at the Museum.
